Music City Star offers rides to St. Jude Rock 'n Roll Marathon ***Train to run special service for runners and supporters Saturday, April 28***

NASHVILLE – For the fourth straight year, Wilson County Mayor and RTA Vice Chair Randall Hutto is partnering with the Regional Transportation Authority of Middle Tennessee (RTA) to transport runners and supporters to the St. Jude Rock 'n Roll Marathon.

The train to the Marathon is a collaborative effort between the RTA, St. Jude Children's Research Hospital, and Wilson County. All ticket proceeds will benefit St. Jude, and Famous Footwear is supporting the special event train as this year's corporate sponsor.

The Nashville & Eastern Railroad Corp. will donate an additional \$5 to St. Jude Children's Hospital for each ticket sold for both the Nashville Rock 'n Roll Marathon and Toast to Tennessee Wine Festival trains.

Train Schedule

Lebanon Station – 5:00 a.m.
Martha Station – 5:15 a.m.
Mt. Juliet Station – 5:25 a.m.
Hermitage Station – 5:35 a.m.
Donelson Station – 5:50 a.m.
Arriving at Riverfront Station – 6:00 a.m.

The return train will leave Riverfront Station at noon (unless the marathon experiences a rain delay) and stop at all stations en route to Lebanon. The train will arrive at Lebanon Station by 1:00 p.m.

Tickets cost \$12 plus a \$1 processing fee, and may be purchased with a credit card through the RTA website or at www.ticketsnashville.com. Tickets will be on sale until 24 hours prior to departure or until tickets are sold out, whichever comes first. Children age 4 and younger will not need a ticket to board; however, they are required to sit in a parent or guardian's lap. Anyone needing special accommodations to board should call 615-862-5950 prior to their trip.
