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WeGo Fall System Improvements coming October 14

Improvements take effect as Level 2 of Central Bus Station reopens for service

NASHVILLE – Starting Sunday, October 14, WeGo Public Transit will implement improvements to seven WeGo routes and one Regional Transportation Authority of Middle Tennessee route as part of the agencies' fall system changes, ensuring reliable transit service for residents in neighborhoods with increased traffic.

All affected routes will undergo schedule adjustments to improve on-time performance, and the updated WeGo routes will feature newly designed schedules as part of the agency's ongoing effort to improve information. Also on October 14, Level 2 of WeGo Central will reopen for service. This will end the on-street bus boardings that have been in effect since renovations began. The facility's 10-year anniversary is later this month.

The new restroom facilities and customer service area require more work before they are reopened to the public.
